After the initial enrollment in a degree program at UM-D, courses taken at other colleges and universities may not ordinarily be applied to the requirements of the degree.

With the exception of courses then actually in progress and so reported to the Admissions Office in writing, a student will not be permitted to transfer to UM-D any credits from any other institution unless official written permission to take them is obtained from his/her faculty advisor and departmental chair in the College prior to registration for them. Such permission is usually routine for the transfer of courses for general degree credit from another UM campus. For non-UM institutions, such permission is granted only for demonstrably extraordinary and urgent circumstances.
